***Introduction to Eventing Clinic* Day 1 & 2 = \$100, Day 1, 2, & 3 = \$150**

**Stabling @ Maple Ridge** - covered stalls - \$ 85.00 weekend includes day fee prior to clinic.

**@ Johvale, Topline, Mary's**, -- \$15 per day- stabling outdoor paddocks only - No stall gates

If the same rider enters a **second or subsequent** regular clinic, the price is \$250 for Johvale (plus add-ons) or \$200 for all other clinics. HTBC only subsidizes one clinic per rider.

**NOTE:** If entering more than one clinic all entries do not need to be sent at the same time as long as extra fees are included for second or subsequent clinics

**NO FAXED ENTRIES**

**\*\*\* NOTE – Entry secretary is NOT the same for all clinics – you need a separate application form for EACH clinic that you wish to enter.**

**To avoid additional fees enter by the Closing date**  
Maple Ridge - **March 22<sup>nd</sup>** / Johvale - **April 6<sup>th</sup>** / Mary's Sanctuary – **May 17<sup>th</sup>**  
Quesnel – **June 7<sup>th</sup>** / Topline – **July 16<sup>th</sup>**  
A late fee of \$30 will be levied after the closing date.  
A \$30 administration fee will be retained for cancellations. A vet certificate may be required.

**OTHER IMPORTANT CLINIC ITEMS:** PLEASE NOTE - In order to participate in these clinics you must be prepared to ride out of an arena, in a group, over uneven terrain.

All clinics will be cross-country instruction with warm up in stadium. The length of time spent in stadium instruction will be decided by clinicians, based on competency level of participants.

**Introduction to Eventing** \*\* Parents and/or coaches are strongly encouraged to attend.

There will be a lecture at lunchtime at all Intro clinics, held on the first day of the clinic at each venue.
