

MEMBERSHIP FOR 2010

There have been some significant changes to the membership structure for 2010, initiated by Equine Canada and subsequently affecting your HTBC fees.

If you are a COMPETITIVE member or HORSE OWNER this is what you need in order to compete in BC:

1. You must obtain your **Sport License** from Equine Canada (same as 2009)
 - a. BRONZE \$20 - PreTraining level and below
 - b. SILVER \$60 - Training level
 - c. GOLD \$100 – Preliminary, Intermediate and Advanced Horse Trials levels
 - d. PLATINUM \$150 – all FEI levels CIC & CCI

2. ****New for 2010****

You must obtain your **Canadian Eventing** membership with your Sport License from Equine Canada. This includes your Omnibus which will be sent to you within one week of obtaining your membership. A mass mailing will be done from Equine Canada for those joining prior to the expected first distribution of the Omnibus at the end of February.

- a. SENIOR membership - \$20
- b. JUNIOR membership - \$18 (17 years of age and under as of Jan 1st, 2010)
- c. SUPPORTER membership - \$15 – does not include an Omnibus and no sport license required

NOTE: Previously your CE membership was included in your HTBC membership fee and submitted to EC on your behalf by HTBC.

3. You must join **Horse Trials BC**. NOTE: 2010 membership fees have been reduced to reflect the changes for obtaining your CE membership as outlined in #2. 2010 fees for HTBC are:
 - a. SENIOR membership - \$45
 - b. JUNIOR membership - \$40 (17 years of age and under as of Jan 1st, 2010)
 - c. If there are more than 2 juniors in a household with the same address, the 3rd and subsequent junior member pays \$25.

4. You must also join **Horse Council BC** which is the Provincial Sport Organization for Equine Canada. Membership fees are as follows:
 - a. SENIOR membership - \$50
 - b. JUNIOR membership - \$40
 - c. FAMILY membership - \$122.50

This fee includes the newly imposed Equine Canada membership fee of \$5 for individual and \$12.50 for family. It also includes \$5 million liability insurance coverage. Your membership as well as club and other affiliate memberships are also available at www.hcbc.ca or by mail to

5. If you are competing at Training level or above your horse must have a **Passport**. Passports are available through Equine Canada.
6. If you are a non competitive member and wish to support our sport, you can obtain a supporter CE membership from Equine Canada. You may also join Horse Trials BC and/or Horse Council.

*** Horse Trials BC will have available for sale a limited number of Omnibus for Support Members or those wishing to obtain a second book. Price of \$13 will include mailing. Omnibus are also available directly from Equine Canada.

Your Canadian Eventing national membership **may** also be purchased at an Equine Canada sanctioned Eventing competition provided the Organiser is willing to collect and forward the application and fees to Equine Canada on behalf of Canadian Eventing (extra charges may be incurred).

However, planning and obtaining your memberships in advance of your first competition or clinic will save you stress, frustration and money.
